**OVEN LOVIN' CHALLENGE** 

THE STOVES IN THE KITCHEN OF THE NORDBY EXHIBIT HALL HAVE NOT BEEN PERFORMING OPTIMALLY IN RECENT YEARS. THIS ISSUE WAS PARTICULARLY EVIDENT DURING THE SPECIAL FOODS CONTEST, WHERE OVEN TEMPERATURES VARIED BY OVER 50 DEGREES, AND THE BURNERS STRUGGLED TO BRING A POT OF WATER TO A BOIL. REFLECTIONS FROM

A VOLUNTEER JUDGE FOLLOWING THE STATE CONTEST: I HAVE
WATCHED THE MAJORITY OF THE 4-H'ERS PARTICIPATING IN THIS
EVENT STRUGGLING WITH FINISHING IN THE REQUIRED 90 MINUTES
DUE TO STOVES THAT DON'T WORK PROPERLY. I HAVE WATCHED THE
FRUSTRATION ON THEIR FACES AS THEY CAN'T GET THEIR ENTERED
RECIPE PREPARATIONS COOKED PROPERLY. I HAVE HAD TO STAND
THERE AS A JUDGE AND WATCH WAS THE YOUNG GIRL WHO STRUGGLED
WITH AN IMPROPERLY WORKING BURNER AND THEN STRUGGLED WITH
AN IMPROPERLY WORKING OVEN, AND THEN RUNNING OVER HER
ALLOTTED 90-MINUTE TIMEFRAME. THAT YOUNG GIRL POWERED
THROUGH AND COMPLETED THE CONTEST; WHEN SHE RETURNED TO
CLEAN UP AND PACK HER EQUIPMENT SHE BROKE DOWN IN TEARS. IN
THE SPIRIT OF POSITIVE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT, BROOKINGS COUNTY
HAS RAISED OVER \$400 TOWARDS THE PURCHASE OF 8 NEW STOVES FOR
