The County Highway Superintendent will advise applicant of necessary culvert sizes, which will depend on approach size and topographic features of the area.

The Highway Superintendent shall have the authority to approve culverts sixty feet (60') in width or less that are spaced in compliance with the State Department of Transportation's specifications for distances between approaches. All other approaches shall be submitted to the County Commission for consideration.

EXHIBIT A
SULLY COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT
SPECIFICATION FOR COUNTY APPROACHES

The attached Specification for County Approaches shall be followed in the construction of roads within Public right-of-ways under the jurisdiction of Sully County. Road construction materials and methods shall conform to the current published edition of the "Standard Specifications for Roads and Bridges" of the South Dakota Department of Transportation, when referenced in the standards below. A copy of these Specifications is on file at the County Highway Department Office.

The following are standards, which shall be met:

1. Culverts shall be sized to assure proper drainage. The minimum circumference of culverts will be a minimum of eighteen inches (18") in diameter. The minimum length of culverts shall be thirty-two feet (32').
2. Gravel surfacing shall meet the requirements of the "Standards Specification for Base or Surfacing". Minimum depth of gravel surfacing shall be four inches (4").
3. Approaches shall be constructed perpendicular as practical to the County Road.
4. Minimum dedicated right-of-way shall be sixty-six feet (66').
5. Only one (1) approach per residence will be allowed. Approaches to General Commercial, Highway Service, General or Limited Agriculture Districts, large tracts or parcels of land will be per South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) 31-24-3 through 31-24-7.
