The Board of Sully County Commissioners held their regular scheduled mtg on Tuesday, September 5, 2023. Chmn Fanger called the mtg to order at 7:30 am. Other members present: Greg Yackley, William Floyd, Jerry Richards & Caleb Shepherd. Also, present were JJ Schall, Emily Sovell, Sheila Ring, Lynette Murphy, Michelle Kleven, Hilary Risner, Oakley Perry & Chuck Trumble

ADOPT AGENDA: Motion by Floyd, second by Richards to adopt the agenda. Unanimous vote aye.

PUBLIC COMMENT: No one was present for public comment.

MINUTES: Motion by Richards, second by Floyd to approve minutes from the Bd of Commission mtg held on August 1st. Unanimous vote aye.

<u>COURTHOUSE WATER DAMAGE PROOF OF LOSS</u>: Motion by Shepherd, second by Yackley to approve Proof of Loss from SDPAA for Claim # 114281 in the amount of \$109,811.52. Unanimous vote aye.

<u>SURPLUS PLANNING & ZONING/GIS EQUIPMENT</u>: Motion by Floyd, second by Fanger to approve surplus of minor equipment from Planning & Zoning & GIS. Unanimous vote aye.

<u>LOCAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANT</u>: Motion by Richards, second by Shepherd to approve Grant Application. Unanimous vote aye.

<u>2024 PROVISIONAL BUDGET HEARING</u>: Hearing was held on 2024 Provisional Budget with no one in attendance. <u>UTILITY LINE EASEMENTS</u>: Motion by Shepherd, second by Yackley to approve Utility Line Easement for Andrew Utech of Codger's Castaway. Unanimous vote aye.

BLADE & PACKER RENTAL: Motion by Yackley, second by Richards to rent blade & packer to City of Onida at a rate of \$150/hour. Unanimous vote aye.

MONTHLY DEPT REPORTS: Bd reviewed monthly dept reports.

SANDER/SPREADER BID OPENING: There were no bids received for sander/spreader.

<u>HWY DEPT</u>: Hwy Supt Schall discussed SDLTAP traffic counts, section lines, PE bridge grants & Bush's Landing Road mag watered with reimbursement from GF&P. Comr Richards shared that he received a phone call regarding wells being placed by Paul Dean Nelson Farm which could result in road issues. He suggested that the taxpayer contact Dept of Natural Resources.

<u>SD FLAP GRANT</u>: Adam Kulesa of GF&P emailed Bd to see if there were any roads in Sully Co that would qualify for a Federal Land Access Grant. Bd discussed Spring Creek Road & Cow Creek Rd. GF&P will contact Hughes Co on Spring Creek Road.

<u>SDSU EXTENSION</u>: Hilary Risner, Oakley Perry & Michelle Kleven met with Bd to discuss Sully County 4-H Program. Motion by Shepherd, second by Yackley to appoint Lynette Murphy as Sully County 4-H Program Assistant at an annual salary of \$6000.00 effective immediately. Unanimous vote aye.

ROAD & BRIDGE LEVY: Bd discussed increasing costs in the Hwy Dept with lack of funding to match. A lengthy discussion was held once again on a proposed Road & Bridge Levy. Timeline was reviewed.
