They informed Bd that the #1 goal is to bring up low level ramp to provide service at all levels for Bush's Boat Ramp. They have had to change the engineering once due to US Corp of Engineer requirements on the 408 Permit & are still having issues. The US Corp of Engineer requirements have almost doubled the cost of the project. Due to the challenge in meeting these requirements they could not guarantee that work would begin in 2024. All were in agreement that road surface would be the last step of the project to protect road. SD Game,
