OPERATING TRANSFERS: Motion by Floyd, second by Yackley to approve operating transfers of \$27,428.00 to 911 Fund, \$10,117.00 to Emergency Mgt Fund & \$500,000.00 to Road & Bridge Fund. Unanimous vote aye.

OUTSIDE OF DEADWOOD GRANT: Motion by Yackley, second by Fanger to approve 2025 Outside of Deadwood Grant Application in the amount of \$10,000.00 for reprs & maintenance to the front of the courthouse. Unanimous vote aye.

BRIDGE REINSPECTION  
PROGRAM RESOLUTION

FOR USE WITH SDDOT RETAINER CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, 23 CFR 650 Subpart C, requires initial inspection of all bridges and reinspection at intervals not to exceed two years with the exception of reinforced concrete box culverts that meet specific criteria. These culverts are reinspected at intervals not to exceed four years.

THEREFORE, Sully County is desirous of participating in the Bridge Inspection Program.

The County requests SDDOT to hire Brosz Engineering (Consulting Engineers) for the inspection work. SDDOT will secure federal approvals, make payments to the Consulting Engineer for inspection services rendered, and bill the County for 20% of the cost. The County will be responsible for the required 20% matching funds.

HWY DEPT PURCHASE REQUESTS: Hwy Supt Schall requested permission to purchase a Jenkins pallet fork at a cost of \$1,100.00 & grapple bucket at a cost of \$3,350.00 for the skidsteer from JPM Sales of Highmore. Motion by Shepherd, second by Fanger to approve request. Unanimous vote aye. Hwy Supt Schall requested permission to purchase cutting edges for the motor graders at a cost of \$11,763.00. Motion by Richards, second by Shepherd to approve request. Unanimous vote aye. Hwy Supt Schall requested permission to purchase miscellaneous signs at a cost of approximately \$5,000.00 to replace existing damaged & worn signs in the County. Motion by Floyd, second by Richards to approve request. Unanimous vote aye. Hwy Supt Schall requested permission to purchase 3-48" x 56' squash pipe culverts to repr Small Structure 60-3284-1158 north of Onida. Motion by Shepherd, second by Yackley to approve request. Unanimous vote aye.

APPROACH PERMITS: Hwy Supt Schall discussed 2 approach permit applications with Bd.

HWY DEPT: Hwy Supt Schall informed Bd that Purple Heart signs have been installed, Brosz Engineering is working on an engineering estimate for the paved roads west of Onida & Agar, road east of Onida, equipment cost increases, culvert south of 13-mile corner & payloader repairs.

305<sup>th</sup> STREET: Aaron Riedell from Ringneck Energy discussed solutions to trucks lining up on 305<sup>th</sup> Street on the east side of Ringneck Energy. Discussion was held on an additional stop sign. Hwy Supt Schall will visit with SDLTAP.
