AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 2017-01

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION OF FIRE HAZARDS IN SULLY COUNTY BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Sully County Commissioners that the following restrictions in regard to open burning be imposed:

SECTION 1:

Sully County Commission may impose a ban to prohibit or restrict open burning in order to protect the public health and safety pursuant to South Dakota Codified Law 7-8-20(18).

SECTION 2:

Open burning defined. For purposes of this ordinance, open burning means the intentional burning of any substance, whether natural or manmade, or the intentional casting off of any burning substance, whether natural or manmade, except the burning of such substance in a container sufficient so as to prohibit the escape of any of the burning substance, or any sparks, flames or hot ashes from the container. The escape of any of such burning substance, or the escape of any sparks, flames or hot ashes from any such container shall be deemed prima facie evidence that the container was insufficient so as to meet the exception from the definition of an open burning set forth herein. The maintaining of a fire in any interior fireplace, stove or furnace, charcoal and wood grill fires at private residences, and permanent fire pits or fire grates located on supervised developed picnic grounds and campgrounds is specifically excluded from the definition of an open burning as contemplated by this ordinance.

SECTION 3:

In the interest of public health and safety no person shall conduct open burning outside the Municipalities and Planned Unit Developments in Sully County when the National Weather Service has <u>forecasted</u> <u>declared</u> the South Dakota Grassland Fire Danger Index to be in the VERY HIGH or EXTREME category or has issued a RED FLAG WARNING for any portion of Sully County <u>for that day or the following day</u>. The prohibition against open burning shall automatically be suspended during any period the South Dakota Grassland Fire Danger Index falls below the VERY HIGH, category, or; the RED FLAG WARNING has been rescinded or cancelled by the National Weather Service. SECTION 4:

The Onida Fire Department Fire Chief, Agar Fire Department Fire Chief and the Sully County Emergency Manager may, at any time upon mutual agreement, declare an emergency for such purposes of fire danger. Such declared emergency shall suspend this Ordinance and enact an on-going burn ban until such time that upon mutual agreement of the Onida Fire Department Fire Chief, Agar Fire Department Fire Chief and the Sully County Emergency Manager that an emergency for such purposes of fire danger no longer exists.

SECTION 5:

Other than when deemed necessary by fire officials for the preservation of life and/or property, exemptions may not be granted during the conditions identified in Section 3.

SECTION 6:

Any person who intends to conduct any "open burning" shall before such burn, notify the Central South Dakota Communications Center (Pierre Police Dispatch) in Pierre, South Dakota at (605) 773-7410 and provide the following information:

Location of the burn

Time of the burn

Substance to be burned

Approximate completion time of the burn

Contact phone number for the responsible person

SECTION 7:

The burn ban status shall be posted to the official Sully County website as well as any official Sully County social media. Such status will declare "Emergency Burn Ban in Effect. No Open Burning Allowed" or "Regular Burn Ban Ordinance in Effect, Use Caution."

SECTION 8:

Violations of this ordinance shall be subject to penalties pursuant to SDCL 7-18A-2; and an action of civil injunctive relief, pursuant to South Dakota Codified Law 21-8. SECTION 9:

All ordinance or parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. This ordinance repeals and replaces Ordinance 2012-01.
