

### CRUSHED GRAVEL SPECIFICATIONS 1" CRUSHED GRAVEL

#### 1" CRUSHED GRAVEL

- 1. Bidder shall furnish all materials, equipment and labor necessary to crush, weigh and stockpile gravel at the Brown Pit in east Sully County.
- 1" aggregate shall conform to Section 882 of the South Dakota Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Roads & Bridges for Gravel Surfacing. Crushed Gravel must meet 6-10 Plasticity Index.
- 3. All pit stripping shall be placed to conform to the pit owner's plan for restoration as provided for by the Surface Mining Act.
- 4. Sully County requires testing material as per specs every 5,000 tons which will be at the cost of the contractor.
- 5. All materials must be crushed by November 1st.

## METHOD OF MEASUREMENT AND BASIS FOR PAYMENT

- Payment for crushed gravel will be paid for at the contract unit price per ton.
- Bidder must submit a certificate of liability insurance and workman's comp proof of insurance.
- Send bids in a sealed envelope marked "Brown Pit Gravel Crushing" to Sully County Auditor, PO Box 265, Onida, SD 57564. Bids will be opened at 7:45 am on April 1, 2025. If due to inclement weather the regular meeting is postponed, bid opening will be held at the following meeting of the Sully County Commissioners.
- Sully County reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids as determined to be in the best interest of Sully County.
