- 1. Bidder shall furnish all materials, equipment and labor necessary to crush, weigh and stockpile gravel at the Sully Lake Pit in west Sully County.
- 1" aggregate shall conform to Section 882 of the South Dakota Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Roads & Bridges for Gravel Surfacing. Crushed Gravel must meet 6-10 Plasticity Index.
- 3. All pit stripping shall be placed to conform to the pit owner's plan for restoration as provided for by the Surface Mining Act.
- 4. Sully County requires testing material as per specs every 5,000 tons which will be at the cost of the contractor.
- 5. All materials must be crushed by November 1st.
